II. Minutes from July 2020 Regular Meeting

A. Eric motioned to approve the June 2020 Regular Meeting minutes, Josh 2nd. Motion Passed

III. Treasurer's Report

- A. Presentation and Approval of Disbursement
 - a. Eric motioned to pay the bills as presented, Josh 2nd. Motion Passed.
 - i. Fuel cost a little higher this month due to agency pump being out of service.
 - ii. Turn out gear was purchased. About \$3,000 per set
 - iii. New radios and pagers purchased

- IV. Public Walk-in/Comments (Online Zoom)
 - A. John Metzger put in an article to the Grand Junction Press regarding rural firefighting and EMS
 - B. Metzger and Sonny Lopez are working on putting together a brochure for the NFPD

V. Old Business

- A. Pension Board Updates
 - a. CPA: Blair and Associates will not do the Actuary but recommended someone for \$10,000
 - b. Attorney says we should have Actuary but CPA says we don't need one for 5 people.
 - c. John will contact Special District representative to see what they recommend.
 - d. The EMS pension plan was recapped.
- B. Nucla-Naturita Mutual Aid
 - a. Meeting on Monday
 - i. They accepted the Mutual Aid.
 - ii. Addendum requested: Response area maps added, Norwood will use Nucla/Naturita channel to communicate due to them not have Norwood's radio channel.
 - iii. Josh moved to approve the amendment. Perri 2nd. Motion Passed

VI. New Business

- A. District Chief Medical Leave
 - a. John needs to get his knee a replacement as well as back issues that might need surgery
 - b. Scott Wederquist said he would be able to cover some of the days he would be out but not all of them
 - c. The departments health plan won't cover the surgery
- B. Secondary full-time paramedic
 - a. EMT-I students Elwood and Marion have completed their classes and passed the National but they have not completed their clinicals.
 - i. They signed a contract that they would respond to calls and if they failed, they would have to pay back \$3,500
 - ii. They have not been responding nor have they been in contact with John. They have failed to fill their contract.
 - b. Wildland Fire response They will only take paramedics
 - c. Hire second paramedic.
 - i. Avg. Colorado pay \$35,000-\$55,000
 - ii. Would take Ambulance 2 to go on wildland fire deployments (Medic and Ambulance would make \$1,250/day at a fire)
 - iii. During off season, the medic would take all the transports
 - iv. During times when no transports are happening, medic will be joint employed by UMC
 - v. Perri & Josh expressed concern about the budget.
 - vi. Eric motioned to have John start looking for a second Paramedic. Jim 2^{nd} the motion. 2 yes, 1 no. Motion passed.

vii. SAFER grant option to pay Paramedic salary: Grant would pay 100% first year, 50% second year, 25% third year

 - i. Members are doing very well.
 - ii. They are responding to calls and being active
- C. Grants:
 - a. Gary Sinise Foundation Grant: to pay for monitors \$65,632. Grant under review.
 - b. Fire Fighter Charitable grant: \$40,000 to pay for the \$10,000 Radios/pagers expense and to continue updating communication equipment
 - c. Master wildland urban interface community assistance grant for community fire mitigation: Deer Mesa, Beaver Pines, Fitz Subdivision fire mitigation projects
